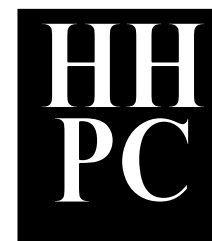


Yun Jung Do

The Parish Council are working with local community groups to revamp the woodland area at Hockley Heath Recreation Ground. Work has already started with the clearing of some trees, holly and ground cover. As the work began, so it was clear that the woodland was an opportunity in waiting! This work has increased the natural light to the woodland floor and will allow bulbs to grow and path ways to be created. Tree stumps will be cut to various shapes creating art forms & seats and it is hoped to install a zip wire and woodland play equipment along with picnic tables etc. The result will be an area for relaxation and enjoyment for all the family.
